

OSHA Regulation

1910.178 (k)(3) Fixed Jacks may be necessary to prevent up-ending during loading and unloading when trailer is not coupled to tractor.

TTMA Technical Bulletin No. 57

2.1 The purpose of this bulletin is to emphasize the potential of trailer nose diving or tail diving under certain conditions of loading or unloading and provide guidelines for reducing this danger by the use of stabilizing devices whenever the trailer is not supported by a tractor or converter dolly.
